Seeks proposals to design and install a sprung maple would floor at its rehearsal space located at 182 Duane Street in Tribeca. The studio is 23' x 32' with 10-1/2' wall height to ceiling. The usable size is 700 sq ft with no obstructions. We are currently seeking bids to upgrade our rehearsal space floor in September, 2006 to a resilient sprung dance floor system consisting of 25/32" x 2 1/4" maple flooring, 2" x 4" sleepers 9" O.C.3/8 neoprene pads 12"O.C., and fire-retardant insulation between sleepers.
