On May 12, 2004 the LMDC released a revised draft Deconstruction Plan for the building at 130 Liberty Street, and formally submitted the plan to the Regulatory Agencies for review. The revised draft plan along with answers to frequently asked questions is available on the LMDC website www.renewnyc.com/130Liberty

At the Public Information Open House, the LMDC and its consultants will provide information regarding the specific components of the deconstruction plan through arranged booths that individuals can visit at their own pace. There will be the opportunity for the public to interact directly with project personnel and gather first hand information about the deconstruction.

Additionally an overview Power Point presentation on the deconstruction plans will begin every half hour throughout the duration of the Open House.

Representatives from the regulatory agencies involved in the deconstruction project will be present as well as additional city agencies and community organizations that will be providing general information to support community health and safety.

Questions and comments about the revised draft Deconstruction Plan will be accepted in writing at the Open House as well as through the LMDC website, and individuals who wish to sign up for the LMDC 130 Liberty Street E Update subscription list will have the opportunity to do so on site.
