On December 13, 2004 the LMDC released a draft of the Phase I Deconstruction Plan for the building at 130 Liberty Street, and formally submitted the plan to the Regulatory Agencies for review. The draft plan along with answers to frequently asked questions is available on the LMDC website [www.renewnyc.com](http://www.renewnyc.com).

At the Public Information Session, the LMDC and its contractors and consultants involved in the deconstruction of the building at 130 Liberty Street, will present an overview of the draft plan for the initial phase of the deconstruction process, which includes the cleaning of the interior of the building and the removal of interior, non-structural materials. The LMDC will discuss the means and methods proposed for these plans along with the regulations the project will adhere to. The presentation will also

include up to date information on the timing and next steps of the deconstruction project.
